It is a FREE event, which in 2018 attracted over 33,000 visits to the 138 venues and in excess of £300,000 in art sales. As a celebration of the variety, range and quality of visual art that can be found across Coventry and Warwickshire, it includes paintings, photography, textiles, installations, ceramics, glassware, stoneware, jewellery, drawings, printmaking and metalwork.
