

In this lecture, Keith Bonser, who became obsessed by the painter and his dramatic life, will follow in his footsteps from his birthplace to Milan, Rome, Naples and the islands of Malta and Sicily, revealing intriguing discoveries about the flawed genius.






Members Workshops – Emma Gluyas
